- Tasks set forth to define the mid to long term growth scenarios.
- Assigned a sub-committee to establish goals and methods of implementation
- All ex-chairman of APSG
  - Jon Stigant
  - Jim Cain
  - John Conner
  - Bruce Carter
- Conner tasked with writing a preliminary document
- Convene in Early December

- Combined with EXEC/TAC meeting
- Conner provided a 3 page document outlining a strategic plan.
  - Based on core APSG goals of education and best practice.

- What can APSG in its present form accomplish?
  - Professional Website
    - Sponsored
    - Rapid delivery of educational information and guidance notes
    - Online viewing of APSG documents, presentations and notes.
    - Perhaps an online forum with APSG advisors as moderators
  - APSG sponsored publications in industry journals
  - Perhaps an electronic newsletter

- Additional items might require funding.
  - Dedicated efforts
  - Operated or sponsored by APSG or others
  - Oversight required, possibly full time
  - Promotions, marketing, advertising
  - Travel and living expenses
- Funding requires changes to APSG structure
- Possible tax and accounting implications

#### What could we do with funding?

- Attend conferences, workshops, industry forums and present talks and, or APSG literature
- Create an event such as a workshop, Geodesy Day to target outside our peer group. This could be an increased involvement in Geoscience Day.
- Investigate and possibly hire professional organizations to teach APSG courses.
- Strengthen alliances with larger industry forums and affiliations. OGP S & P is already happening.
- Education involvement at lecture, awards and possibly sponsorships.
